

BACS Library Curbside Pickup Program

Any student who wishes to, may place holds on books they want to check out and pick up to have at home. Students may check out up to 6 books at a time, and keep books for two weeks (this may be extended when requested or necessary for a school assignment).

When a student's account is full (6 books) they will not be able to check out new books until some books have been returned.

The library will use the school's material drop off/pickup day (Mondays 12pm-2pm, and 7:30-8:30pm) for exchange of books, as well as Thursdays from 7:00-8:00pm.

Procedure:

- Using the available instructions and videos, students and their families can search the library's collection of books.
- Students should choose "hold it" on any books they want to check out, selecting up to 6 books.
- Librarians will gather a student's choices and have them ready for pickup
- Parents will receive an email saying that the books are ready for the next available pickup day (if a pickup time doesn't work for a parent then email the librarians to set up other arrangements)
- Library book returns can be brought back on these pickup days as well

Remember that the library's digital collection of eBooks and audiobooks is also available for checkout instantly. We have created instructions and videos for using our digital platform, MackinVia, so you can access and check out all our eBooks and audiobooks.

A note on the COVID precautions the library is taking:

The librarians always wear masks and gloves when working in the library and handling books. When books are returned they are quarantined for 3 days before being checked in and put back in circulation. If you have any concerns, please let us know.
